She recommended a general perennial seed or general annual seed, the latter would require planting every year. She confirmed that the meadow would take 5 – 10 years to mature. Members discussed the procedure and concluded that a small area would be trialled on land off Berkley Way junction Beech Way off Church Way and that a site visit would be arranged to determine the area to be trialled.
